

## Nathaniel Silberschlag

Nathaniel Silberschlag was appointed principal horn of The Cleveland Orchestra in May 2019, and took up the position in August prior to the start of the 2019-20 season. Silberschlag has performed with the Juilliard Orchestra, the New York Philharmonic, the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, the Romania State Symphony, New York's Little Orchestra Society, and the Orpheus Chamber Orchestra. He has also played concerts with a variety of ensembles, including the Orpheus Chamber Orchestra.

At the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts, Silberschlag was a member of the National Symphony Orchestra Youth Fellowship program and a recipient of the Center's "Brass of Peace" scholarship program. He also served as a fellow at the Center's Summer Music Institute. He was a fellow at the Manhattan School of Music during the summers of 2017 and 2018, and in 2018 was named one of the "Rising Stars" with the New York Philharmonic as part of their 2018 Global Outreach Initiative.
